

Advantages LIBISnet

- LIBIS follows closely the international standards and the developments in library automation
- LIBISnet stands for networking. The information about the collection of the library is available in part of a large catalogue increasing the visibility of the library's collection
- Cataloguing books and serials can be done by adding local information to existing records (shared cataloguing). This means an important time profit

Advantages LIBISnet


- Only limited hard- and software investments are necessary.

Quality of service prevails!





Our approach


- Not a technology project...




The Change Curve
