



## Search in the NALIS Libraries

This search is performed in the bibliographic database of the NALIS Union Catalogue, i.e. in the bibliographic records for books, periodicals and other types of materials kept in the libraries of the NALIS library network.

To initiate this search you should first click on “Library search” at the top of the homepage, then write **one or several words** in the search box placed under “NALIS Libraries”

and press on .

Example:

Shakespeare

Acting Shakespeare

- ✓ If you want to search for a **phrase**, place it in quotation marks (“”).

Example:

"Shakespeare's audience"

- ✓ If you use logical operators – AND, OR, NOT – capitalise them, otherwise they would be interpreted as part of the text.

Example:

use AND history

You will retrieve all the information resources that have the two words – *use* and *history* – in their respective bibliographic description.

usa OR history

You will retrieve all the resources that have either the word *use* or the word *history* in their respective bibliographic description.

NALIS Libraries

usa NOT history

You will retrieve all the resources that have the word *use* but do *not* have the word *history* in their respective bibliographic description.

- ✓ For **symbols**, use a question mark ('?') to replace one and an asterisk ('\*') to replace more symbols.

Example:

NALIS Libraries

wom?n

In the results list you will have all the information resources which have the word *woman* or *women* in their respective bibliographic description.

NALIS Libraries

cultur\*

In the results list you will have all the information resources which have words beginning with *cultur-*: *culture*, *cultural*, and *culturally*.

- ✓ To **group words** use round brackets ('()')

Example:

NALIS Libraries

shakespeare (tragedy OR sonnet)

In the results list you will have all the information resources which have the words *Shakespeare* and/or the word *tragedy* or the word *sonnet*.

Using various search options:


Next to the search box you will see another one where "NALIS libraries" appears. Click on

▼ to choose from a drop-down list the catalogue you want to search in:

- ✓ **NALIS libraries** indicates all the libraries which have submitted bibliographic data to the NALIS Union Catalogue;
- ✓ **founding libraries** – the Libraries of BAS, the St. Kliment Ohridski University Library and Panitza Library of the American University in Bulgaria;
- ✓ **associated libraries** – the actual list of these libraries is published under [Associate Membership](#) on the NALISF website.

Under the search box there are three drop-down menus:

1. Type of material



2. Type of search: ▼

that contain my query words – the search is performed by the words you have written in the search box

with my exact phrase – the search is performed by the phrase you have written in the search box

3. By the type of field to search:

anywhere in the record – in all the fields of bibliographic information

in the title – in the title fields

as author/creator – in the author/creator fields

in subject – in the subject heading fields

Full Text – not only in the fields for bibliographic information, but also in the full-text article itself (if accessible).

### Results list

The results list is comprised of two main parts:

The left part is split into three sections:

1. **Show only** – which divides the results list in online materials and items kept in the libraries (without showing which of the letter have been borrowed). Round brackets signify the number of the items found. Every type itself is a link to the respective search results list.
2. **Refine My Results** – by topic, creator, collection, creation date, resource type, language, LCC classification. Round brackets signify the number of the items found. Every type itself is a link to the respective search results list.
3. **Suggested New Searches** – suggestions for other information resources from the same creator or on a similar topic. Round brackets signify the number of the items found. Every type itself is a link to the respective search results list.

The right part is structured as follows:

If you misspelled the search word, a “Did you mean....” suggestion will appear of a similar but proper word.

#### Example:

Did you mean: **shakespeare?**

Did you mean: **tragedy?**

The correct word is a link to the respective results list.

What follows is the number of search results and where the search was performed.

#### Example:

**231 Results for NALIS libraries**

There are options for filtering and for granting access to the available items only, as well as to the online materials – by clicking on the respective link.



A thumbnail indicating the type of the item and its type.

Next to the picture a short bibliographic description is given (author, title, publisher, publishing place and date). **Available at** / **Check holdings at** indicate the library where you can find the item.





The *Annals of Human Biology* journal can be found in two subscribed databases: Scopus and SwetsWise.

Chose one of those, press on , then there will be two options:

1. If your PC's IP is in the subscribed IP range, a window with the periodical will open where also some subscribed information will be shown:

You need to select a year, issue and the article itself in order to get access to the full-text item.

2. If your PC's IP is not in the subscribed IP range, you will come to the home page of the subscribed database where you will be required to sign in (otherwise you will not be able to use the full text article).

## Hamlet Retooled As Action Hero: [FINAL Edition]

If any character in Shakespeare deserves the kind of imaginative spadework that has been applied to Hamlet. Still, the production -- and audiences -- pay a price. What has been neglected is a similar development of many of the other pivotal characters, from Claudius to Gertrude to Ophelia. (Aubrey, gentle, devoted Horatio is a notable exception; James Denvil, too, offers a dignified turn as the ghost of Hamlet's father. And the "Animal House" antics of James Flanagan and Brandon McCoy generate a certain comic mileage for their Rosencrantz and Guildenstern.)

This is the rare "Hamlet" in which malevolent Claudius (Nigel Reed) -- you will recall that he murdered the king, marries Hamlet's mother and in the process usurps the throne -- is rendered as fang-less: a snore of Elsinore. Or in which the madness of Ophelia (Kathleen Coons) appears to be just some hang-up. (Coons is actually quite strong in the mad scene; it's the staging of the "To the nunnery" scene which Ophelia is cast off by Hamlet, that seems undercooked.)

As played by the young Washington actor Karl Miller, Hamlet is a most unhappy fella. You knew, of course, that the Dane was a melancholy sort, but maybe you were unaware of just how down on the world he could be. When this Hamlet examines the skull of his old friend Yorick, he doesn't merely ruminate on the futility of life. No, he takes out his feelings about life's bitter brittleness on what's left of Yorick himself -- by breaking it into little pieces.

**Language:** – from the drop-down menu you can select the language of the interface: Bulgarian (default) or English.
