





# Long Term Vision

- Local catalog linked to a chain of services
- Infrastructure to permit global, national or regional, and local discovery and delivery of information among open, loosely-coupled systems
- Massive aggregation of licensed & digitized publications, special collections, and born digital materials online
- Many starting points on the Web leading to many types of information objects
- Integrate library-managed collections into the user's workflow on the network





# OAIster

- Aggregation (union catalog) of harvested open access collections
- OAI-OMH
- 25 million records, 1100 contributing institutions
- Began at University of Michigan; now managed by OCLC
- Going to self-service contribution model (Digital Collections Gateway)

# OCLC's Digital Collections Gateway

- Self-service tool for uploading to WorldCat
- Freely available to members and non-members of OCLC
- Makes digital content more visible
- Compatible with all OAI-compliant repositories

### Most widely held works by Paisii

[Slavens nobülgarska istoria](#) by Paisii (Book)

63 editions published between 1914 and 2003 in 4 languages and held by 89 libraries worldwide

The Slavo-Bulgarian history by Paisii of Hilandar, originally written in 1762. Several minor inscriptions on the back cover, including signatures of those who read the work dated 1883, 1885, 1913 and 1906. Ornamented headings and initials.






